 Eligible age limit: Players born on or after 01/01/2000 can participate in this championship.

2. Entries:

Normal entry - four players in each category can represent the each district.

Special entry - any other player who remits rs 800/- can participate in this championship.

All entries including special entries should come through the concerned affiliated district association.

Entry fee of selected players is 300/- and special entries 800/- per player.

All the participants should be a registered player of the concerned affiliated district association.

- System of play: This championship will be played under FIDE's Law of Chess and the Swiss system.
- 4. Default time: default time for arriving to the seat before the chess board 15 minutes from the start of game.
- 5. Time control: 60 minutes + 10 seconds per move.
- 6. Tiebreaks: 1. Direct encounter, 2. bucholz cut 1, 3. bucholz,
- 4. sonneborn berger.
- 7. Protests: protests if any, against the decisions of the chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is allowed.
- Tournament committee. The organisers will form a tournament committee for the smooth conduct of the championship.
- 9. interpretation: for interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament the decision of the tournament committee shall be final and binding on all. Te tournament committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules without prior notice, however such changes/inclusions will be subject to CAK clearence. Such changes will, however be displayed in the tournament hall.
- 10. Withdrawal: a player may withdraw at any stage of the event only after informing the chief arbiter in writing.

11.Registration of players with CAK: all participants in the championship should be registered with CAK for the year 2019.

12. Electronic devices

In addition to the usual regulations for mobile phones and electronic devices players are fobidden to wear any kind of wrist watches. Players wearing wathes will be declared lost.
