2. Opportunity:

The top Two players from each category as well as the best player from Government schools in both categories (in total 3 boys and 3 girls) will get a life time chance to visit the Olympiad and also to interact with grandmasters and other elite participants through simuls, lectures etc. These players will also be extended 3 nights stay free of cost to witness the Olympiad. In addition, an amount of Rupee 2000/- will be reimbursed for selected player as travel expenses.

3. Eligibility:

- a) Player must be born on or after 01.01.2007.
- b) Player must be from Kerala.
- c) AICF registration is compulsory for all the players.
- d) All entries must come through the concerned Affiliated District Chess Association.

4. Entries:

No Entry Fee will be charged and players must submit Google form before the last date of the entry.

Google form link: https://forms.gle/CNT3Uht1fYQJhgDr6 (Maximum number of entries may limited to 200) Last Date of Entry: 14th June, 2022.

- 6. Prizes: A total of 25-trophies shall be awarded to the winners (boys and girls separately total 50 trophies) and E-Certificates will also be awarded to all the players.
- 7. System of Play: The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system.
- 8. Default Time: Default time for arriving to the chessboard is 10 minutes.
- 9. Time Control: The rate of play shall be 25 minutes with an increment of

10 seconds per move from move number one.

- 10. Tie Break: Following is the order of tie-break:
 - (a) Buchholz Cut1
 - (b) Buchholz
 - (c) Sonneborn Berger
 - (d) Direct encounter
 - (e) The greater number of wins (forfeit included)
 - (f) The greater number of wins by black
- 11. Protest: if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- within 05 Minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- 12. Appeals Committee: Before the commencement of the tournament, a five-member appeals committee shall be formed by the Chess Association Kerala.
- 13. Withdrawal: if any player is absent for any round without intimation to Chief Arbiter, he/she will be removed for all the remaining rounds without further notice.
